UNPLANNED MAINTENANCES

REGION F

Suburbs affected: Kibler Park and Mayfield Park
Reasons for Interruption: Major burst on 600m steel line

Streets Affected: Various

Start date and Time: 25 June 2024 08:00

End date and time: 25 June 2024 15:30

Impact on Customers: No Water for the duration of hours

Reasons for disruption(s): Major burst on 600m steel line

Alternative Water Supply: Roaming Water Tankers

Benefits to the Customers: Improve service delivery and continuity of water supply

REGION G

Suburbs affected: Lenasia and Lehae Ext 1

Reason for interruption: Repairs on a vandalised isolating valve on a bulk water pipeline

Following the closing of the Cosmos Reservoir to repair a vandalised isolating valve on the bulk pipeline, it was found that the valve needs replacement. Temporary measures have been put in place to enable supply of water while the relevant materials are being sourced for the valve replacement.

While these interim measures are in effect, some areas may experience lower water pressure.

Areas affected: Lenasia (all areas and extensions) as well as Lehae Ext 1. There is currently no estimated time for completion.

REGION B

Fairlands water supply

Johannesburg Water is aware of the water supply in Fairlands, where residents are experiencing poor pressure to no water. Johannesburg Water's technical teams are currently on the ground investigating the issue in the area. Further updates will be provided once they become available.
