Sewer Infrastructure Upgrades

Region F

Affected areas: Kensington

Streets affected: Queens Street, Langerman Drive, Westmoreland Road, Nottingham Road, and Derby Road

Start date: 19 March 2026

End date: 15 May 2026

Reason for interruption: Replacement of existing 375mm sewer pipeline with a 400mm sewer pipeline

Impact on customers:

- Road closures and restricted access to parts of Queens Street
- Construction activity (excavation, machinery, noise)
- Possible temporary sewer-related inconveniences during certain stages of the work
- Occasional odours in the immediate work area

Mitigation measures:

- Johannesburg Water teams will be on-site throughout the project
- Honey sucker trucks will be deployed where it is necessary to manage sewer spillages
- Work will be monitored to minimise disruption to residents

Benefit to customers:

- Improved sewer capacity
- Reduced blockages and overflows
- Enhanced reliability of sanitation services
